## Antelope Canyon

Antelope Canyon is one of the most breathtaking and tranquil places on earth. Gently carved from the Navajo sandstone over the course of countless millenniums, the slot canyons are majestic and narrow passages, just enough space for a small group to walk the sandy floor-and for the occasional shafts of sunlight to shine down from above. The Navajo name for Upper Antelope Canyon is Tse'bighanilini, which means "the place where water runs through rocks." Upper Antelope Canyon is at about 4,000 feet elevation and the canyon walls rise 120 feet above the streambed.

## Cardiac Canyon

Cardiac Canyon is carved out of Navajo Sandstone. There are areas that you have to climb to get to other sections. Cardiac Canyon is for experienced hikers, you must be relatively fit with moderate skills.

This tour is guided by our experts who will give you an overview of the geology, flora and fauna of the area.

## White Pockets

Here you will find countless swirls and splendid brainrocks.

There is a gray rock layer, sometimes only a few centimeters thick, above the red sandstone that makes the whole landscape look like if it was covered in icing sugar. Some hills resemble a checkerboard, other shine in a golden glow, but it's the red and white colors that prevail at the White Pockets. In some spots the stone layers are completely twisted, just like an enormous marble cake. It's almost unbelievable, that these rocks were not artificially made and that they are just ancient petrified sand dunes. Everyone who wanders across the White Pockets will have to stop from time to time, take a breath and gaze with amazement. Especially during the evening hours this area will remind you of a Candy Store.

## South Coyotes Buttes

This desolate land contains a disorderly collection of fantastically twisted and striated sandstone. Multitudes of the beehive shaped hills or buttes appear to be enveloped in a sea of colorful petrified waves while other bizarre formations have been contorted into caverns, arches, domes and fragile fins - all slowly crumbling as they continuously succumb to the forces of nature.
